How to remove moss from your roof:



1. Climb

SAFELY Get on your roof.

2. Inspect

Check and make sure none of the shingles or under layer of the roof are damaged.

3. Wash & Scrub

Get rid of that moss as best as possible, WITHOUT DAMAGING SHINGLES OR ROOF MATERIALS.

4. Sanitize (Optional)

Purchase or make "Moss spray" and apply to the roof to help remove moss, and prevent re-growth.

5. Cut & Remove

Remove anything that might be creating a favorable environment for moss to grow: tree branches, leaves, standing water.
